

OGI Systems to launch GEMSCRIBE in Hong Kong Fair

OGI Systems Ltd will be launching GEMSCRIBE, a leading, state-of-the-art system for inscription on the diamond's girdle during the Hong Kong Show. The system is touted to be powerful, accurate, stable, practical and easy-to-use with many exclusive features.

In the course of the exhibition, visitors can see and experiment the GEMSCRIBE first-hand. Visitors will be able to inscribe on an unlimited number of stones and get the feel of a high-tech system.

The GEMSCRIBE has already been sold to quite a few labs worldwide and has become an immediate success owing to a number of added benefits which distinguish it from other similar systems.

GEMSCRIBE can inscribe on diamonds of different sizes, ranging from 5 points to 1,000 carats, and on all diamond shapes. It also can inscribe on some other gemstones, and on some embedded stones too. Furthermore, the size of the fonts, numbers and shapes can range from 20 to 250 microns. The system supports numerous Windows fonts, including Chinese.

Another unique feature that GEMSCRIBE has is a built-in Inscription Viewer, which takes snapshots of the inscription, after which the bitmap image can be added to the diamond's certificate.
